All Season Passes must be paid in full at time of purchase. Season Passes are not transferable. In the spirit of giving, Season Passes are not valid during events that are held for charity. Please review Responsibility Code with all family members prior to signing.

Procedures for lost or forgotten passes:

There will be \$10.00 charge for a replacement of season's passes or for "forgotten passes". Anyone allowing another person to use his or her pass for skiing/snowboarding will have that pass revoked with no refund. Criminal charges may be pressed. Please do not allow anyone else to use your pass.

Season Pass Requirements for Family plans:

Family members constitute, husband, wife, and dependent persons. Dependent person are those defined as such by the IRS for the current tax year. Due to our ID system, photos must be taken at Maple Ski Ridge, Inc. Check our website for picture dates. Applications that are received by cut off dates will receive those current rates even thou pictures for passes are to be taken at a later date or on first day of skiing.

Skiers / Snowboarders Responsibility Code

There are elements of risk in skiing / snowboarding that common sense and personal awareness can help reduce.

- 1.) Ski under control and in such a manner that you can stop or avoid other skiers or objects.
- 2.) When skiing downhill or overtaking another skier, you must avoid the skier below you.
- 3.) You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above.
- 4.) When entering a trail or starting downhill, yield to other skiers.
- 5.) All skiers shall use devices to help prevent runaway skies.
- 6.) You shall keep off closed trails and posted areas and observe all posted signs.

Warning to skiers and snowboarder: Downhill skiing, as other sports, contains inherent risks, including but not limited to the risk of personal injury, including catastrophic injury or death or property damage, which may be caused by variation in terrain or weather conditions or surface or sub-surface snow, ice, bare spots or areas of thin cover, moguls, ruts, bumps or other persons using the facilities: or rocks, branches, forest growth, debris, roots, stumps, or other natural objects or man-made objects that are incidental to the provision or maintenance of a ski facility in New York State. New York State law imposes a duty on you to become apprises of and understand the risk inherent in the sport of skiing, which are see forth above, so that you may make an informed decision of whether to participate in skiing notwithstanding the risks. New York also imposes additional duties upon you, to which you must adhere, for the purpose of avoiding injury causes by any of the risks inherent in skiing. Complete lists of these responsibilities are posted at the area under the NYS Industrial code rule #54 (safety in skiing). If you are not willing to assume all of these risks and abide by these duties, you must not participate in skiing at this area. Maple Ski Ridge, Inc. is not responsible for the weather or the length of the ski season. We typically try to stay open for early closing due to weather.
